It starts as a series of interviews with five women artists and thinkers and their perspectives on trying to fit their ambitions and talents into a world that doesn't quite have a place for them. It's almost like a kind of origin story, with a group of female protagonists who will change the world; and Strand's allusive, dreamy filmmaking quickly departs from the conventional and takes us inside the heads of the camera subjects (and the filmmaker).
